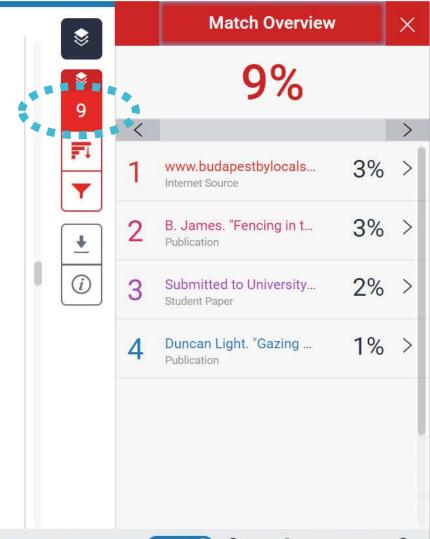
Fig. 1 The panoramic view of Statue Park¹

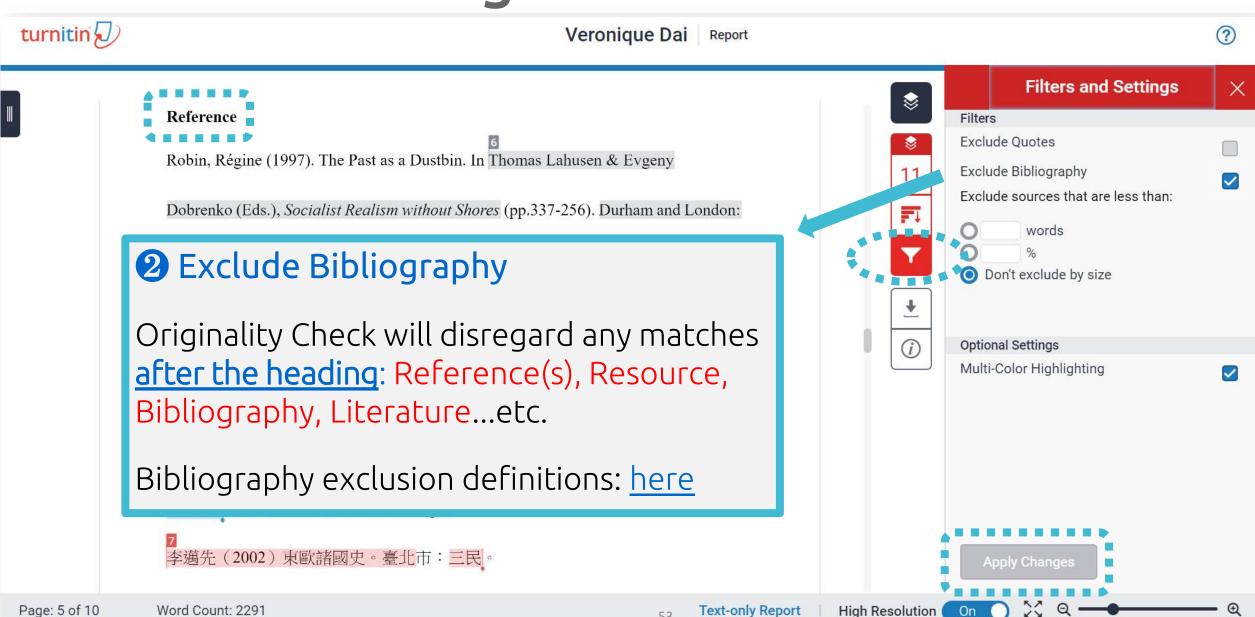

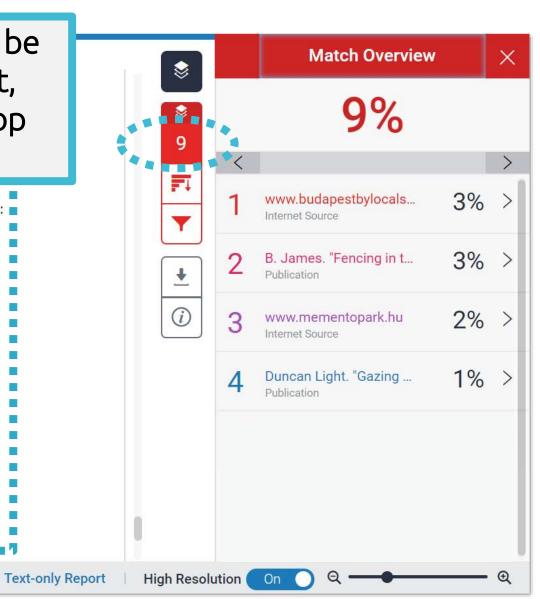

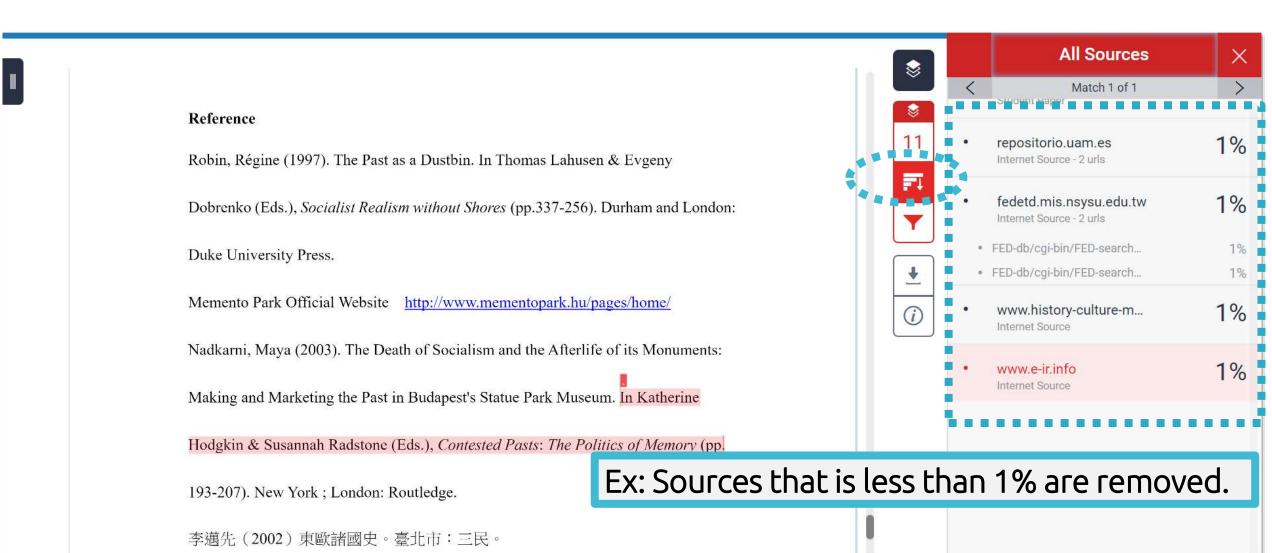

Could you tell me what percentage of Similarity score given by Turnitin is appropriate?

In my case, I got 19% from Turnitin, is it OK?

Turnitin is a tool detecting text similarities.

The similarity score is <u>NOT</u> the plagiarism indicator. Human interpretation is always required.

High similarity score ≠ Plagiarism

It may include false positives. False positives could be:

- 2 1. Terms usually used in your field, grammatical terms, the names, affiliations, methods and methodology.
- 2. Reference list, properly cited and/or quoted text or text for which permission has been received.
- 3. Your own published paper or work stored in Student Paper database.

Consult your instructor on enhancing the original writing

Revise the text.

Or you may use the filter to reduce the similarity score with the advisor's permission.

'No Magic Number'



Therefore, based on the above situation, it is difficult to clearly define an ideal similarity score.

The best way is discussing the appropriate criteria with your department or your instructor/advisor.

Or refer to the publishing policy of publishers and journals. EX: IEEE.

2020/Dec/23 updated

- 1. As Academic Affairs Conference resolution on Nov. 2020, postgraduate students are required to submit a similarity report with advisor signature.
- 2. Please note that you must <u>contact</u> with <u>your</u> <u>department/institution</u> about the similarity regulation and <u>implement details</u>, there is no general standard suggestion from the Library.





Q1 Any regulation about similarity percentage?

A1 It depends on your department or institution, please contact your department office directly. There is no regulation from LIBRARY.

Q2 It results in high similarity score, what should I do next?

A2 Please discuss with your Advisor to modify texts, sentences or re-cite references. Turnitin may highlights some commonly-used words and phrases in your research filed, thus, you MUST discuss with your Advisor about suggestions for revision.

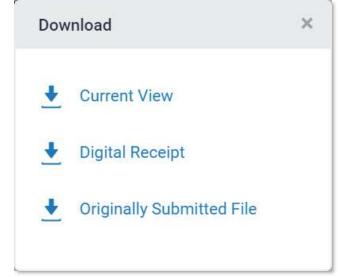
Q3 The similarity report has been matched my published academic papers or articles, what should I do next?

A3 Your Advisor must confirmed that you are the author of the academic article. To exclude sources from the similarity report, please ask your advisor to apply an instructor account.

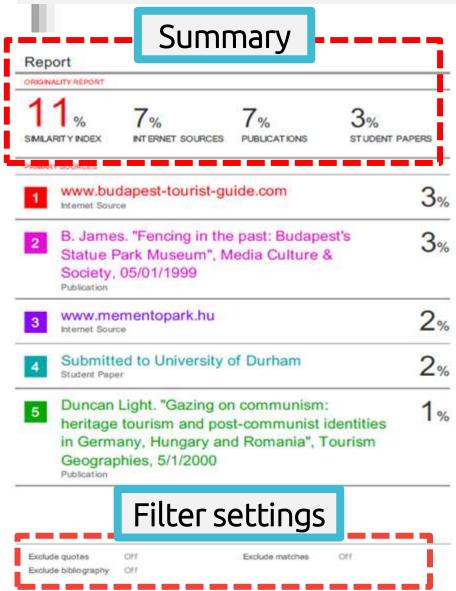

Soviet Union in the late 1940s adopted an aggressive ideological campaign to consolidate the regime through East-Central Europe. The most visible aspect was the massive public display of revolutionary symbols in cities under iron curtain: Flags feature the hammer and sickle, emblems of unity between industrial and agricultural workers in the class struggle; Buildings were crowned with Red star of communism, posters of Marx-Engels-Lenin-Stalin on the wall, whilst statues of heroes and communist comrades were creeted, with heads uplifted, staring unblinkingly into the future.

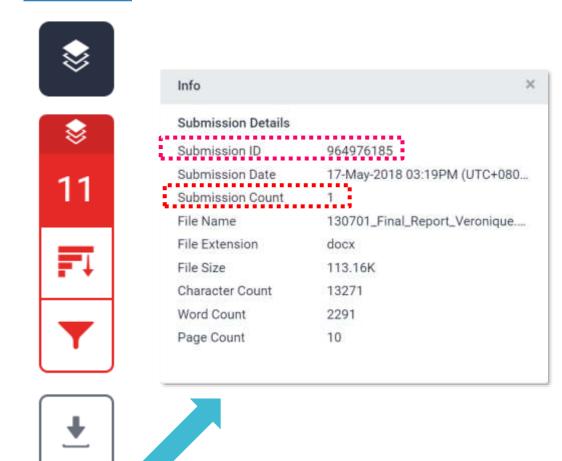
When the Easter- Central European dictatorships demised in 1989-90, political upheavals often followed with popular demonstrations in which many visible symbols were destroyed: socialist-inspired street and square were quickly renamed, emblems as the Berlin Wall or the Stalin statue were torn down, and the fate of these public memorials carving communist ideology became an important issue. Some material legacy can be rapidly effaced. However, other built heritage – the plethora of monumental buildings or tower blocks built for industrial workers- will persist for much longer, reminding a period of history that many people want to forget

Despite most people in this region has confusing attitude toward this recent past, they can't stop a tide-like growing interest among Western tourist of material legacy of communism. In consequence, many former-associated communist sights were constructed as "attractions" for the gaze of Western tourist. The promotions of these

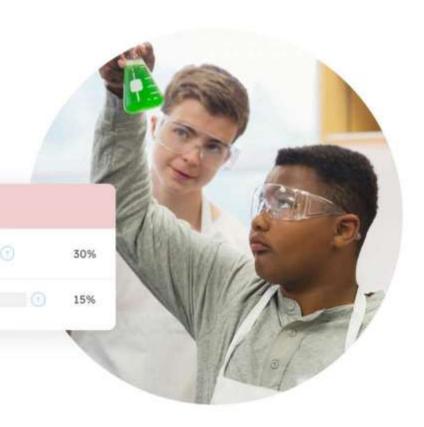

Frequent Asked Questions



1. My deadline of oral defense is approaching, but my similarity report is still "processing". Can I get my similarity report early?

Turnitin is a cloud-base system. The process time of a report depends on the file size and pages that your submitted. We suggest you to <u>submit your papers SEVERAL DAYS AHEAD of your oral defense</u>.

If your report has been pending as "processing" for a half day:

- (1) Examine the submission counts in ①, if you have submitted papers to this assignment more than 3 times, after that each time you have to wait 24 hours before a new paper showing up.
- (2) You may remove references, table of contents, images and graphs, keep only the main text and save it as a new file to resubmit one more time.

» 2. I got a high similarity score, and the first matches are my previous drafts, what can I do? • If you are using the folders created by NCKU Library to submit your papers:

Your papers will **NOT** be stored to Turnitin student repository. Any resubmissions would be a new one and will not match to your previous drafts.

- 2 If you are using the folders created by your own advisor and found high similarity matches that were your previous drafts:
- (1) Consult the advisor who enrolled you into his/her class for help.
- (2) Your advisor is able to <u>exclude sources in All source mode</u>. He/she could help you to exclude your previous drafts or certain sources. The report will refresh itself and reduce the similarity score.
- (3) If you request to delete previous drafts, contact your Department Office or your advisor. Only they could apply to the Library for paper deletion request.

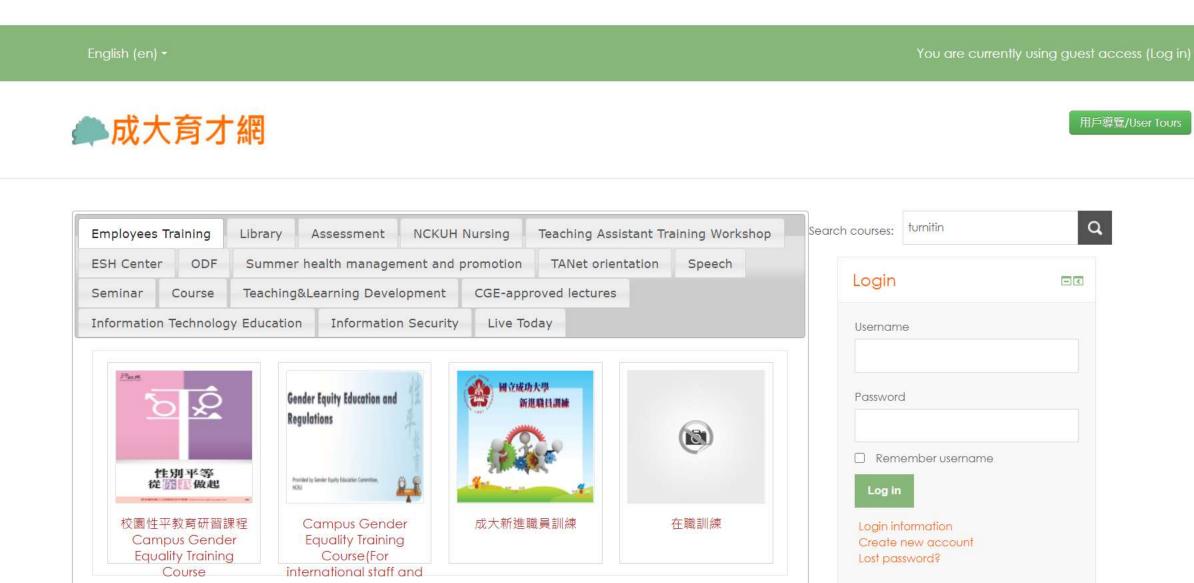
